Day 1. Saturday - 14 November 2026 (Tokyo) / 13 February 2027

To end the day on a high note, you'll head to the **Tokyo Skytree**, the tallest structure in Japan and the tallest tower in the world. Take in breathtaking panoramic views of the city, a perfect way to wrap up your unforgettable day in Tokyo. After touring Skytree you will head enjoy a delicious, included dinner.

Day 3. Monday - 16 November 2026 (Mt Fuji) / 15 February 2027

Start your day with a delightful, included breakfast. Today promises adventure and breathtaking sights as you set off on your private tour to witness the majestic **Mt. Fuji**. Rising to an impressive 3,776 meters, it is Japan's tallest and most revered peak. For centuries, Mt. Fuji has been a sacred symbol, deeply influencing Japanese culture and perceptions of nature. Gazing upon its awe-inspiring beauty is an unforgettable experience—one that will leave a lasting impression for years to come. On your return to the hotel you will enjoy a delicious, included Japanese dinner.

Day 4. Tuesday - 17 November 2026 (Hiroshima) / 16 February 2027

After enjoying breakfast, you will board the Shinkansen for a scenic journey to **Hiroshima**. Please note that your large suitcase will be sent ahead to Kyoto, so be sure to pack an overnight bag for your two-night stay in Hiroshima. Upon arrival, you will spend the afternoon exploring the **Hiroshima Peace Memorial Park and the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum**, a profoundly moving experience that offers insight into the city's history and resilience.

In the evening, you will check into your beautiful hotel overlooking **Hiroshima Bay**, where you will unwind and savour a traditional Japanese dinner, immersing yourself in the local culture and flavours.

Day 5. Wednesday - 18 November 2026 (Hiroshima / Miyajima Island) / 17 February 2027

After enjoying your included breakfast, we will have a leisurely island day. As a group, we will journey by boat to the breathtaking **Miyajima Island**, renowned for its stunning scenery and cultural landmarks.

For lunch, embark on your own culinary adventure—Miyajima is famous for its fresh oysters and delicious seafood, offering a variety of local flavours to discover.

On arrival at the island, we will make our way to the amazingly beautiful **Miyajima Ropeway and ride to the top of Mount Misen**. Here you will have unsurpassed views of Miyajima Island and Hiroshima Bay.

While on the island, you can visit iconic sites such as the sacred Itsukushima Shrine and its magnificent floating Torii Gate, the elegant Five-Storied Pagoda (Gojunoto), the bustling **Omotesando Shopping Arcade**.

After a day of exploration, you may return to the mainland at your own pace. In the evening, enjoy an included Japanese buffet dinner, enjoying the seasonal foods of Hiroshima.

Day 6. Thursday - 19 November 2026 (Kyoto) / 18 February 2027

After enjoying a delicious breakfast, you will take a taxi to Hiroshima Station for your Shinkansen journey to the beautiful and historic city of Kyoto.

Along the way, we will make a short stop to explore the breathtaking **Himeji Castle**, a masterpiece of early 17th-century Japanese architecture. Known as "**The White Heron**" for its elegant, soaring design, Himeji Castle stands as the finest surviving example of traditional Japanese castle craftsmanship.

Following your visit, you will continue your journey to Kyoto, where you can unwind at your hotel before enjoying a thoughtfully prepared evening meal, marking the perfect end to a perfect day. Tonight, you will also be reunited with your large suitcase.

Following dinner, you will embark on a tour of the iconic **Kyoto Tower**. From the observation deck, you'll be treated to panoramic views of Kyoto and, on a clear day, even catch a glimpse of Osaka in the distance. It's the perfect way to wrap up a fun filled day.

Day 7. Friday - 20 November 2026 (Kyoto) / 19 February 2027

You'll start the day with a delicious, included breakfast before setting off on an enriching journey through Kyoto.

Our morning begins with a short taxi ride to the awe-inspiring **Kiyomizu-dera Temple**. Here, your Tour Escort, John, will guide you through the temple's fascinating history and breathtaking architecture.

After exploring Kiyomizu-dera, you will stroll down the charming Teapot Lane, a vibrant shopping street lined with traditional stores and enticing market stalls. Take your time to browse unique souvenirs and savour delectable Japanese treats from the local restaurants.

Next, you make your way to the imposing **Chion-in Temple Gate**. This temple gate is the largest temple gate in Japan.

After observing this beautiful Temple Gate, we will ride via taxi to the amazing Nishiki Market. **Nishiki Market** is referred to as the "Kitchen of Kyoto." Operating since the early 1300s, this bustling market offers an array of traditional Japanese food items to sample, from fresh seafood to pickled delicacies. As you stroll through the market, you'll also find unique shops selling everything from finely crafted knives and bowls to beautiful chopsticks – the perfect souvenirs to remember your time in Japan. You will find something interesting and fun for lunch at Nishiki Market.

Tonight, enjoy an included dinner at our hotel. Afterward, for those eager to explore further, John will lead an evening walk through Kyoto Station, where you'll visit the Kyoto Viewing Deck, stroll across the Skywalk on the station's rooftop, and admire the beautifully illuminated staircase—a perfect way to end a memorable day.

Day 8. Saturday - 21 November 2026 (Kyoto) / 20 February 2027

After enjoying your included breakfast, get ready for an exciting day exploring Kyoto with your Tour Escort, John, as your guide.

We begin our journey with a taxi ride to **Sanjusangendo (Rengeo-in) Temple**, home to 1,001 breathtaking statues of Kannon, the Goddess of Mercy. Dating back to 1164, this awe-inspiring temple offers a profound and serene experience. As a sign of respect, you will be required to remove your shoes before entering, and photography inside the temple is not permitted.

After departing Sanjusangendo, you will travel via taxi to a traditional Japanese tea house to experience an authentic **Kyoto-style Tea Ceremony**—an unforgettable highlight of your journey.

Following the Tea Ceremony, we will take a short walk to the subway for a quick 10-minute ride to the iconic Fushimi Inari Taisha Shrine. Here, you can immerse yourself in the beauty of the famous vermillion Torii gates that form a mesmerizing pathway behind the main shrine. You may choose to take a short stroll through the gates or explore the lively market area surrounding the shrine, where you can sample delicious Japanese street food or enjoy lunch at one of the many charming local restaurants.

After our time at **Fushimi Inari Taisha**, we'll take a quick 10-minute train ride back to Kyoto Station. Upon arrival, John will guide you through the highlights of this impressive station, including its fascinating food floors, where locals shop daily for fresh ingredients and prepared meals.

We'll return to our hotel in the afternoon, allowing some time to relax before dinner.

For those who wish to explore further after dinner, John will take you to the beautiful Fushimi Inara Taisha Shrine. This is a beautiful shrine, best seen at night as it is mysterious and spiritual. The night tour is also a must as there will be fewer tourists and will make the experience more enjoyable.

Day 9. Sunday - 22 November 2026 (Kyoto) / 21 February 2027

After enjoying your included breakfast, you will embark on a wonderful day of exploration, traveling with your Tour Escort, John, to the stunning Arashiyama district—one of Kyoto's most picturesque and beloved destinations. Upon arrival, you will experience the enchanting **Arashiyama Bamboo Grove** in a truly special way—on a traditional **Japanese rickshaw ride**. As you glide through the towering bamboo forest, your rickshaw driver will take stunning photos of you in the private section of the grove, capturing memories of this serene and magical setting. The gentle rustling of the bamboo in the wind creates an atmosphere unlike any other, making this a uniquely Japanese experience.

After your rickshaw ride, we will take a leisurely walk to the historic **Togetsukyo Bridge**, which spans the magnificent Katsura River. This scenic spot offers fantastic photo opportunities and is frequently featured in period films due to its timeless beauty.

For lunch, you'll have the freedom to choose from the many wonderful restaurants and street food stalls along Arashiyama's bustling main street, where you can sample local specialties and browse charming gift shops.

Following lunch, you will embark on a **scenic boat ride along the Katsura River**, a relaxing and enjoyable experience that allows you to take in the breathtaking natural beauty of Arashiyama from the water.

Our final temple stop is the impressive **Nijo Castle**, an architectural treasure known for its grand interiors and unique "nightingale floors," which chirp softly underfoot to warn of approaching intruders—a clever security feature from the samurai era.

After a morning rich in cultural discovery, you'll enjoy a delicious, included **lunch** before we head to **Gion**, Kyoto's historic Geisha district. As you wander through its narrow, lantern-lit streets, John will share fascinating insights into the traditions and mystique of this unique neighbourhood. With a bit of luck, you might even spot a **Geisha / Geiko** or **Maiko** (apprentice Geisha) heading to an evening engagement.

We'll end this unforgettable day with an **included dinner** at a traditional Japanese restaurant, where you'll savour authentic Kyoto cuisine. Afterward, John will accompany you back to your hotel on our bus. This day offers a perfect blend of beauty, tradition, and cultural immersion—highlighting some of Kyoto's most treasured experiences!

Day 12. Wednesday - 25 November 2026 (Kyoto) / 24 February 2027

After enjoying your included breakfast, you will travel to the Sekka Shibori Scarf Museum.

Using your included Suica card, you will travel by subway with your Tour Escort, John, to experience a private Sekka Shibori scarf class. During this hands-on workshop, you'll learn the traditional Japanese art of dyeing, using the intricate sekka shibori technique to create your very own silk scarf. By the end of the class, you'll have a beautiful, personalized piece to take home as a special memento of your time in Japan.

For lunch, you'll take part in a hands-on **Sushi Class**, where you'll learn the art of crafting delicious sushi — a fun and valuable skill to take home with you to Australia.
